Gifts of \$5,000 or higher

ADVISORY BOARD:

Donors making gifts at this level are invited to serve on PennPAC's Advisory Board. - PennPAC volunteers and leaders informally yet effectively provide **mentorship** to Penn students and recent alumni nonprofit entrepreneurs. We seek funding to expand the program with more frequent and formalized counsel.
- **Adopt-a-Project** or an entire semester of consulting engagements to support our impact on nonprofit clients.
